- Verb be: am, is, are (ser, estar)

I → **am**

Positive: I am a teacher.

Negative: I am not (I'm not) a student.

Interrogative: Am I late? Yes, you are. / No, you aren't,

Positive: He is sad.

Negative: She is not (isn't) sleeping.

Interrogative: Is it raining? Yes, it is./ No, it isn't.

Positive: We are at home.

Negative: You are not (aren't) running.

Interrogative: Are they at the supermarket? Yes, they are. / No, they aren't.
